



# Synod on Synodality Listening Session – Participant Reflection Questions/Notes

## 1. Listening

Listening is the first step, but it requires an open mind and heart, without prejudice.

- How is God speaking to us through voices we sometimes ignore?
- What facilitates or inhibits our listening?
- What are some limitations in our ability to listen, especially to views other than our own?
- What space is there for the voice of minorities, especially people who experience poverty, marginalization, or social exclusion?

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#### 2. Celebration

"Walking together" is only possible if it is based on communal listening to the Word and celebration of the Eucharist.

- How do prayer and liturgical celebration inspire and guide our common mission in our community?
- How do we promote the active participation of all the faithful in the liturgy?
- Who are those missing from our prayer and liturgical celebration?
- What encouragement is offered to participate in the ministries of our local Church?
