### **Donation to Archdiocese of Houma-Thibodaux**

The Archdiocese of Louisville made a donation to the new Archbishop's diocese in Louisiana in recognition of Most Reverend Sheldon Fabre's appointment as the new Archbishop of Louisville. Fr. Lou suggested that St. Leonard likewise acknowledge Fr. Fabre's appointment with a parish donation of \$500. The council agreed.

**Synodal Process**

The STL listening session will take place on 3/19 from 10-12 in the cafeteria. Staff will facilitate the session with assistance from PC members. A letter will be forwarded to parishioners and a youth table will be provided at the session. The parish will also solicit online feedback. Refreshments will be served. Fr. Lou will share the timeline and materials being used by SFR.

**Other Updates**

Stations of the Cross for Peace in Ukraine will be conducted.

The Catholic Relief Services collection is this month. CRS is the largest aid organization in the world next to the United States.
