The council also proposed an outreach committee and a subcommittee of the PC to build upon the things STL is doing. Will, Julia, Ray and Gary volunteered to serve on this committee and agreed to meet before the next meeting and include Teresa Riggs, Fran Mastropaulo, and Carol Sexton for perspective on the activities they are are involved in.

The PC discussed the importance of getting people involved through personal invitations especially sat the beginning of the year during Stewardship renewal. It was also suggested that we highlight ministries on Donut

Sundays; possibly conduct targeted listening sessions around parish life; and measure engagement in outreach, formation and ministries.

Event Highlights and Upcoming Events

Allison reported that Homecoming netted great results - \$14,499.09! The Silent Auction netted \$4,200. Lifehouse (STL) and Eastern KY Flood Relief (SFR) both received \$482. Smaller wheels and a bigger cake booth for next year were suggested.

The next event is a Food Truck night on 10/14 (subsequently cancelled). Allison is working on a Food Truck Invasion in November after Mass either on Saturday or Sunday in November

Other Updates

The council was excited about the three challenges that have begun occurring at Sunday Mass. Council members were reminded about the Common Table soup subscription and the Caring Friends ministry. Fr. Lou shared that there are nine students in confirmation preparation. The council suggested a report/update from the staff be available before each meeting.
